Willis Exhibit Hall - Open Division

TO ENTER: Entry for non-perishable departments (i.e., Handiwork, Heritage Skills and Visual Arts) will be July 21 and 24, 2023, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Madison County Extension Office, 230 Duncannon Lane, Richmond. If items are excessive in size, awkward to handle, or weigh over 40 lbs., please contact the Extension Office to make alternate arrangements as items will be transported by extension staff to the fairgrounds for judging. Garden, Horticulture, Canning, Honey, and Foods must be dropped off at the Madison County Fairgrounds in Willis Hall, 3237 Old Irvine Road, Richmond, on Wednesday, July 26, 2023, from 2:00 to 6:00 pm. We encourage those with multiple entries to pick up entry tags at the Extension Office prior to July 26. If you have questions, call 859-623-4072.

RULES:

- "Open Division" means open to Madison County <u>residents only</u>, of all ages, unless youth age-specific class. All entries must be original work (not from a kit or purchased), made by the exhibitor and completed since the last county fair. This is an individual competition, no group entries accepted. Only family friendly entries will be accepted. There is no fee to enter your items in Willis Exhibit Hall Open Division. Please bring a picture ID with address.
- Limited to one entry per class for each Exhibitor, including "other than listed" classes. "Other than listed" class must be an entry that does not qualify under any other listed class in the division. Department, division, and class is defined as follows:

<u>Example</u> : HORTICULTURE = department
Division 2 – Plants & Flowers = division
19. Rose, any variety = class

- Once entry is submitted you must leave the judging area! You will not be allowed to view other submissions until the fair officially opens on Friday, July 28, 2023. Entries will be on display in a climate-controlled facility from day of entry through **August 4, 2023.**
- All entries must be picked up on Saturday, August 5, 2023, between 9:00-11:00 a.m. No early pickup allowed. Premium money will be disbursed at that time. Exhibitor must retain duplicate part of entry tag to identify and reclaim article at pick up. Any items not picked up during this time will be available at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Office during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., for a period of two weeks, starting August 7th.
- The Fair Board and the Madison County Cooperative Extension Service, and their volunteers, shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to any item entered.
